Prof. Dr. Adem Şahin was born in 1958 in Ordu, TURKEY. In 1979 he graduated from Hacettepe University, Faculty of Social and Administrative Sciences, Department of Business Administration and in 1983 from İstanbul University, Institute of Business Economics. He obtained his Masters degree at İstanbul University, Faculty of Economics in 1984, and then in 1988 his PhD. From 1982 to 1989 he served as Research Assistant, from 1989 to 1991 as PhD Research Assistant, from 1991 to 1996 as Assistant Professor, and from 1996 to 1999 as Associated Professor at İstanbul University, Faculty of Economics, Department of Economy Politics.

Between 1999-2000, Mr Şahin worked as Deputy Undersecretary a, and between 2000-2007 as Undersecretary at the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.

Since his retirement in 2007, Mr. Şahin Works at TOBB University of Economy and Technology, Faculty of Economic and Administrative Sciences, Department of Economics as faculty-member and teaches several courses at undergraduate and graduate levels as 'Engineering Economy', 'Tourism Economy', 'Turkish Economy', 'Current Issues in Turkish Economy'.
